The Monitoring Committee on going through the file resolved to accept that the GF+7F Commercial building at Door No.19, 4<sup>th</sup> lane, Nungambakkam High Road in R.S.No.51/9, Block No.10 of Nungambakkam village, Chennai had been completed before 28.02.1999. The Letter No. 35199/UD-I/97-6 dated 01.02. 1999 of H& UD. (Appeal under section 79) stating the existence of 4<sup>th</sup> floor to 7<sup>th</sup> floor and Chennai Corporation property tax ID No. 07-109-0785-000 (view DCB) statement dated 22.11.2017 from the year I/93-94 to II/17-18 was considered as credible evidence to prove that the building was existing prior to 28.02.1999. Regularisation may be considered subject to obtaining revised NOC from DF&RS stating the application under section 113A of T&CP Act instead of Section 113 C stated in the NOC dated 25.01.2018 and Structural Stability Certificate from Registered Structural Engineer.

#### General

i) The committee observed that the role of Monitoring Committee in examining the regularisation applications placed before it is limited to the extent of deciding on the completion of building before the cut off date of 28.02.1999 and it is the DF & RS that

has to decide on the safety measures to be provided in the building before issue of NOC for regularisation.

- ii) The Committee suggested to evolve a mechanism to link non obtaining of fire licence with enforcement action.
- iii) The Committee directed the DF & RS to insist the building owners to erect boards in a prominent place in the building informing the public about the alternative fire safety measures installed in the building and conditions stipulated in the fire licence.
- iv) The Committee suggested that the Planning Permission details shall be permanently displayed in the commercial special buildings and multi storeyed buildings and also directed to amend the rule for Completion Certificate to include this condition for permanent display.
- v) The Committee was informed of the pendency of regularisation applications in the MSB category. The Committee agreed to conduct meetings periodically to dispose all the pending cases early.
